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Introduction

Affiliate marketing is a relatively easy way to start earning online. In order to start, you don't need to create a product, manage inventory, or handle customer support. Instead, you earn a commission when someone makes a purchase through your referral link.

However, success in affiliate marketing doesn't come from promoting just about everything. Rather, it comes from recommending the right products to the right people with honesty and consistency.

In this guide, you will learn the basics of affiliate marketing and how to use this method to monetize your online business.

What Is Affiliate Marketing?

Affiliate marketing is a partnership between you and a business (e.g., an online merchant).

The process is quite straightforward:

1. Join an affiliate program.
2. Receive a unique referral link.
3. Share helpful content featuring the product or service.
4. A visitor/reader clicks your link and makes a qualifying purchase.
5. You earn a commission.

Remember: Your value lies in helping people make informed decisions. This is not simply about placing links everywhere, which may be annoying to some individuals.

Step 2: Recommend Suitable Products

Ask yourself:

- ☐ Would I use this myself?
- ☐ Does it genuinely solve a problem?
- ☐ Does it have positive reviews?
- ☐ Does the company have a good reputation?
- ☐ Does it fit my audience?
- ☐ Would I recommend it even without a commission?
 - Make sure you only recommend products that you can stand behind.
